Introduction

Thank you for purchasing this quality product. To minimise the risk of injury we urge that our clients take some basic safety precautions when using this device. Please read the operation instructions carefully and make sure you have understood its content.

Intended use

The felling bar is a powerful aid for everything to do with tree work. Whether as a log lifter or a universal felling aid – the bar is an effective all-rounder. Because of the length, there is excellent leverage.

Product description

The felling bar can easily be attached to the log. The curved handpiece enables a secure and firm grip at the same time. With the felling tool, tree trunks can be turned around their longitudinal axis. In addition, the felling bar can serve as a supportive force when felling with a chainsaw. A felling cut is carried out two-thirds. The felling bar is pushed into this cut, and the further cut is carried out below its position. If the cut is sloped, the felling bar and the saw chain are protected.

- Use the right tool for the job at hand. DO NOT try to use small devices to work on larger industrial devices. There are certain applications for which this device was developed. If the felling bar is used for precisely these applications, it works more safely and effectively. DO NOT use the felling bar for tasks for which it is not intended.

Work area safety

- Check the work area before each use of the felling bar. Keep your work area dry, dirt-free, and well-lit. Cluttered, wet, or dark work areas can lead to injuries. Using the felling bar in narrow work areas can lead to dangerous proximity to cutting tools and rotating parts.
- Keep children and bystanders away from the work area while you are operating the felling bar.
 Do not let children work with it.

Personal security

- Stay vigilant and always keep an eye on the felling bar while working. Do not use it when you are tired or under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or medicine. A moment of inattention during operation can lead to serious injuries.
- Dress properly. Do not wear loose clothing, hanging objects, or jewellery. Keep hair, loose clothing, jewellery, and gloves away from moving parts, as they can get caught in them.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment if necessary. Use approved protective goggles (no visual aids) with side shields or, if necessary, with a face shield. Use a dust mask if a lot of dust





is raised during work. Also use non-slip safety shoes, a hard hat, gloves, dust collection systems and, if necessary, hearing protection. This applies to everyone in the work area.

• Do not underestimate the situation. Always make sure that you have a good stance and keep your balance.

Safety in use and care

- Do not use the felling bar forcibly. Tools are safer and more effective when used in the way they are intended to. Plan your work and use the right tool for the job to be done.
- Check the felling bar for damaged parts before each use. Check carefully that it is working properly and that it is performing its intended function.
- Replace damaged or worn parts immediately. Never use the felling bar if any part of it is damaged.
- When not in use, keep the felling bar in a dry, safe place out of children's reach. Check the tool to ensure that it is in perfect condition before storing it and before using it again.
- Only use accessories recommended by the manufacturer for use with the felling bar. Accessories that are suitable for a specific tool can lead to the risk of injury when used on another tool.
- Keep the protective devices in place and in good working order. Never operate the felling bar without the protective devices in place.

Specific operating warnings

- The rated load capacity must not be exceeded.
- Do not stand under or near the felling bar while the load is upright.
- Before using the felling bar, make sure that all screws are tightened.

Maintenance

Regularly maintain the felling bar. It is recommended to check the general condition of every tool before use. Make sure that the felling bar remains in a good condition. Keep it clean, dry, and free from oil and grease.
