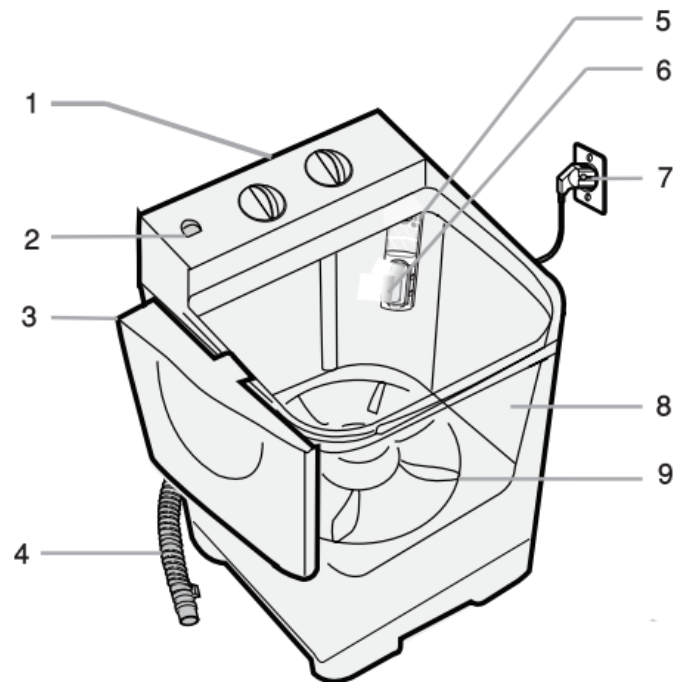
Safety instructions

- The device is not intended for use by persons (including children) with impaired or limited physical, sensory, and mental abilities or lack of experience and/or real knowledge, unless they are supervised by a person responsible for their safety or follow the instructions made by this person on how to correctly use the device.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the device.
- Never connect the earth plug to a gas pipe, water pipe, telephone cable, or lightning conductor.
- Do not use the device in case the power cord or plug is damaged. **Danger of electric shock! Fire hazard!**
- Only use the hoses included. Old hoses must not be used again.



<p>Do not expose the washing machine to direct sunlight or rain.</p>	<p>Do not place the washing machine to a humid location.</p>	<p>Make sure that no water may contact the plugs and switches.</p>
<p>Let the water thoroughly drain from the drain tube.</p>	<p>Do not disconnect the plug by pulling the cable.</p>	<p>Keep the washing machine away from fire or sources of heat.</p>
<p>Do not wipe off the washing machine with flammable material (e.g., petrol).</p>	<p>Do not pour water exceeding 60 °C into the washing machine.</p>

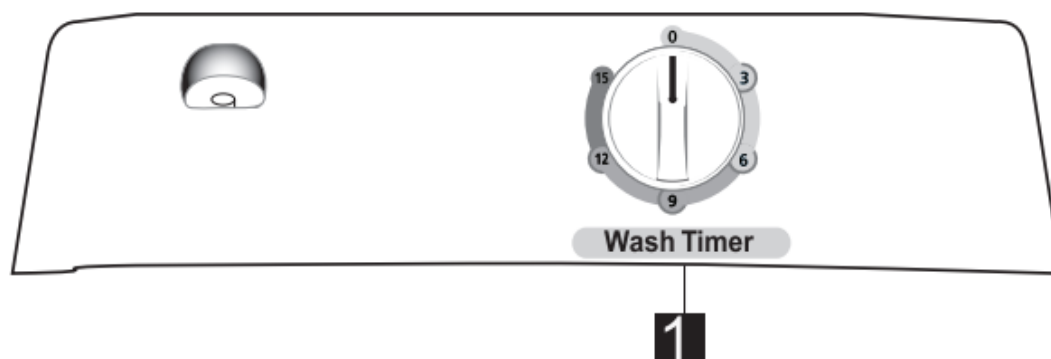

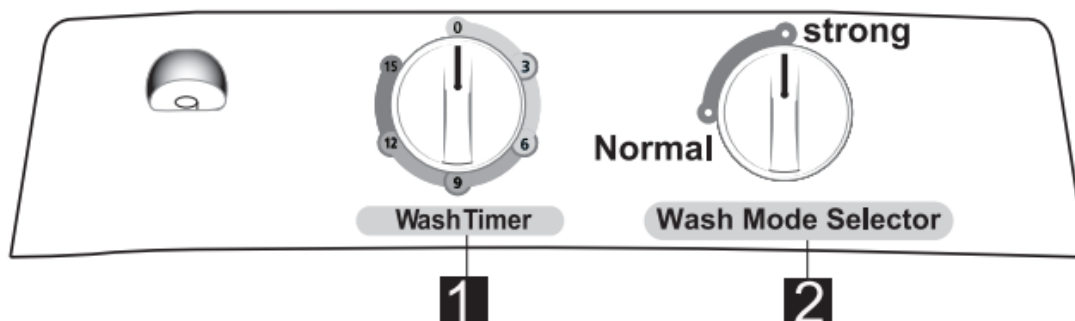

Control panel

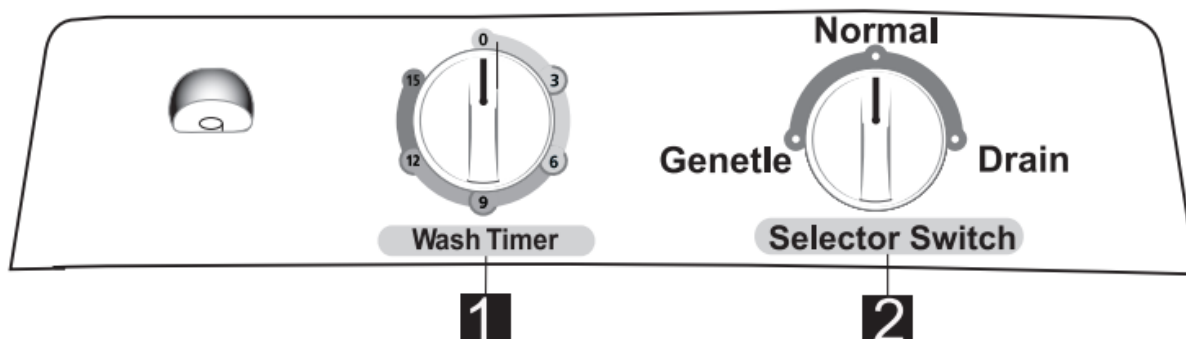
The control panel and water inlet vary depending on the model of the device. Refer to the control panel corresponding to your device.

Using the double water inlet

The machine has two water inlets. Each drum has a separate water inlet.

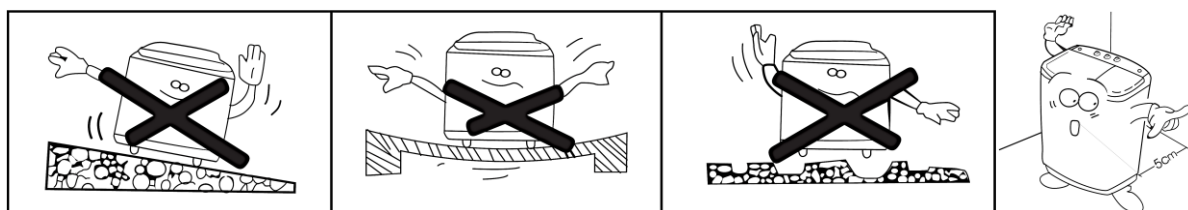
Attention!

- The maximum water inlet pressure is 3 bar.
- The minimum water inlet pressure is 0.2 bar.

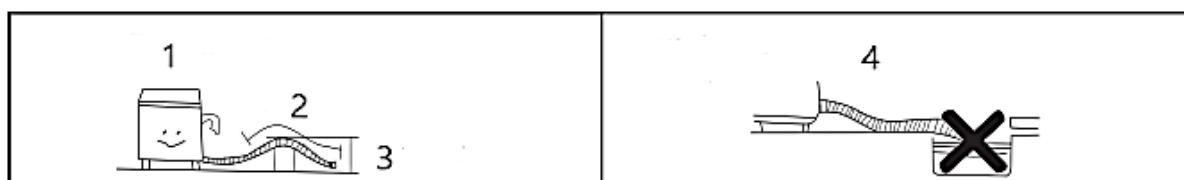
If spin-drying does not come to a standstill in the space of 12 s after opening the lid, stop operation and contact an expert.

Installation

- Place the washing machine to a level and stable surface.
- Keep the washing machine at a distance of more than 5 cm from the wall to avoid noises during washing.



Connecting the drain hose (if there is no drain pump)



No	Name/description
1	Drain hose extension
2	Below 2 m
3	Below 15 cm
4	The end of the drain hose must never be put into water.

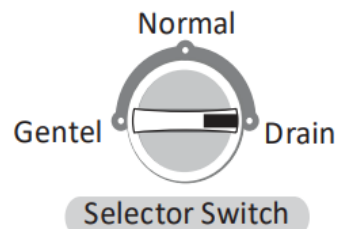
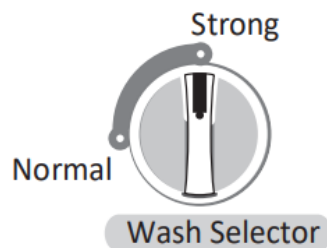
Operation

Preparing clothes before washing

<p>Make sure that all objects such as keys, pins, or coins are removed from the clothes.</p>	<p>Greasy or coloured clothes should be washed separately.</p>
<p>Turn inside out before washing fleecy clothes.</p>	<p>Wash delicate clothes in a nylon net.</p>

Washing

- Before washing, note the following:
 - Connect the water-inlet hose and open the water cock.
 - Connect the power cable to the power supply.
- Switch the washing selector switch to the desired washing mode.
- Place the clothes that should be washed into the washing drum.
- Pour water into the washing drum, then add detergent.
- Set the washing timer to 1–15 min.

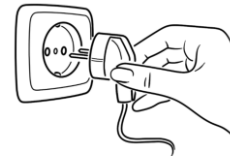






Type of clothes	Washing time (min)	Setting
Very solid, heavy fabric	10–15	Strong
Linen, cotton, etc.	8–10	
Normal clothes (socks, etc.)	7	Normal
Somewhat solid synthetic fibre	2–5	
100 % wool, mixed wool, fine synthetic fibre with label demanding hand wash only	2–5	

Maintenance

- After washing, disconnect the plug from the mains.
- Clean the device with a clean, dry, and soft cloth.
- The drums need to be cleaned after lading lest no deposits form.
- Remove the fluff filter and clean it.
